

Please review these common questions as you prepare and practice for your interviews.

GENERAL INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

- Tell me about yourself.
- Where do you see yourself professionally in 5 years?
- Please share one strength and one weakness (something you are improving on).
- How would your friends, faculty, or supervisors describe you?
- What was the most valuable thing you learned through (an experience)?
- How do you learn best?
- What test or project are you most proud of?
- How do you handle stress and/or conflict?
- Do you have leadership experience?
- What role do you take in group work? Provide an example.
- Is there anything else you would like us to know about you?
- What is your proudest accomplishment?
- Tell me about [this experience] on your resume. (Be ready to talk about everything on your resume).
- What questions do you have for us?
- What type of environment do you want to work in?
- Have you had professor/clinical instructor/supervisor that has inspired you? What about them inspires you?
- What are three things that you are looking for in an employer?
- What type of relationship do you want with your supervisor?
- Why should we choose you?
- What skills can you offer us?
- Can you share your experience working others from diverse backgrounds?
- Please share a time where you collaborated with others to achieve a goal?

BEHAVIORAL & SITUATIONAL QUESTIONS

- Tell me when you had to take on a job or responsibility and complete it even though it wasn't your job.
- Tell me about a time when you showed leadership.
- Tell me about a conflict that you've experienced and how you worked to resolve it.
- Identify a time that you made a mistake and how you learned from it.
- Tell me about a time when you didn't complete everything you needed on time.
- Tell me about a time that you had difficulty in group project.
- Tell me about a time when you experienced failure or a time you were disappointed and how you handled it.
- Tell us about a time when you were being thorough and noticed something that you would have missed if not.
- Tell me about having to work with someone who you disagree with or knew would be difficult.
- Tell me about a time when you were working on a project and other people were slacking, how you handled it.
- Describe a situation when you had several things to do in limited time.
- Tell me about a time when you had to learn something new in a short time.
